Dear Anne Milgram:

On December 2, 2020 the United States voted, along with the majority of other Countries in the United Nations, to accept the medical use of Cannabis and remove it from the most restrictive category of the Single Convention Treaty.

In voting to support this measure, the United States acknowledged that in recent years, well controlled clinical trials have identified legitimate medical use of cannabis preparations, stating that “the legitimate use of a Cannabis preparation has been established through scientific research, and Cannabis no longer meets the criterion for placement in Schedule IV of the Single Convention”.

I am requesting an expedited review and response to this rescheduling petition as it has already been 7 months since it was received by the DEA.
