ORDER

Upon consideration of the petition for writ of mandamus and the supplement thereto, it is

ORDERED that the petition be denied. Petitioner has not shown that “no adequate alternative remedy exists” to pursue his requested relief. Citizens for Resp. & Ethics in Wash. v. Trump, 924 F.3d 602, 606 (D.C. Cir. 2019). Specifically, petitioner can submit to the Drug Enforcement Agency a new rescheduling petition under 21 U.S.C. § 811(a), and he can petition for review of any denial of such a petition.
